

### **Starting the system**



Show you printing card to the card reader. Choose a language and a shooting setup (Don't use "Background effect"). The camera(s), microphone(s) and lights start up accordingly. The control panel opens up.

#### Info about the system

Log in with your printing card. The card has to be registered with your account at least on the previous day.


Having signed in, chosen a shooting setup, image sources, (A,B) and their layout, a video image should appear both on the control panel and the large preview monitor.

Recordings are automatically saved to your account in the Unitube loader (https://lataamo.helsinki.fi), where you can download them later for editing or link them e.g. to a Moodle course. Videos are not saved to the studio computer.

It is also possible to livestream video alongside recording. Cameras and mics can also be used in Zoom/Teams: connect a laptop with the provided USB cable or use the desktop computer in the studio. Select the computer on the Video communication page within the control panel.


## **Preparations**

- Organize the shooting scene: furniture, equipment, props, notes, direction of the preview monitor.
- Attach a laptop or log in to the studio computer, choose the image sources and layout, frame the image. See instructions on the other side.
- Confirm the microphone(s) to be used in the sound settings (= button in white). Replace if necessary.
- Listen to the speech with studio headphones before recording. Speak into the tripod microphone 20-30 cm away. You can also listen to the live streaming (see the link and QR code in the another paper). You can adjust the volume in the settings.
- Ensure the lighting of the scene. Adjust as needed from the control panel settings (Shooting Lights).
- Select Dual Mode if you want to save e.g. camera images separately. Set the image sources (A & B) ready and do not switch during recording. Only one image source is shown in the panel, even though both are saved as different files.





# How to use the control panel



# **During recording**

- NOTE: Make all camera and light adjustments from the control panel. You can move the camera and microphone on the stand, but do not touch the equipment mounted on the ceiling.
- Look at the camera you are using (the "viewer") as much as possible. Pause the recording if necessary with the button.
- Remember to speak close to the tripod microphone (if used).
- If the correct image is missing, try changing image sources.
- Changing the image layout can black out the monitor for a while. However, the black box is not recorded.

## After working

- Stop recording with the stop button on the control panel.
   The video is transferred to the Unitube loader for processing.
- 2. Turn off the system from the button in the upper right corner.
- 3. If you have moved furniture or boards, return them to their correct places (see instructions in the speaker's booth).
- 4. Don't turn off the studio computer, just log out if you used it.
- 5. Turn off the wireless mouse and keyboard.
- 6. Turn off overhead lights when you leave.
